DO THIS				
Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away, warn other traffic. Check for spills, leaks. Call the emergency services: Dial 111				
Keep all bystanders away. Wear goggles, half face-piece respirator with combined dust and vapour cartridge, full length clothing and PVC gloves. Sweep up spilled product and place in a sealable container for disposal. Wash down affected area with water plus detergent. Seek advice from local authority regarding disposal.				
Call the Fire Service: Dial 111. Wear PVC protective clothing and breathing apparatus. Extinguish fires with foam, dry chemical or carbon dioxide. During a fire, toxic fumes may be released. Contain run-off. Keep non-involved persons away.				
DO NOT induce vomiting. For advice contact the National Poisons Centre 0800 POISON (0800 764 766) or a doctor immediately.				
Hold eyelids apart and flush the eye continuously with running water for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention.				
If skin or hair contact occurs, remove contaminated clothing and flush skin and hair with running water. Do not scrub the skin.				
Remove patient to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-nose. Get medical attention if symptoms develop.				

STORAGE AND SEGREGATION SUMMARY

Storage: Store in original container in a cool, dry, ventilated place away from direct heat or direct sunlight. Store away from foodstuffs, animal feed, children and animals. Keep container sealed when not in use.
